New Products And New Markets

ur plans for 2008 was to introduce several new products into the market and we have been successful with three new ones. First was the Beefy Cheese Cocktail Patty which is sold to COSTCO Northeastern Division in select clubs and the sales are very strong. The Beefy Cheese Cocktail Patty will be a seasonal item and will be in stores September through December just in time for the holiday season. Second was the Chicken Pot Pie Patty which comes in a microwaveable ten pack and is sold to all 179 BJ's Club Stores. The sales have been outstanding which exceeded our expectations. Third, the Beefy Cheese Full-Size Patty sold to SAM's Club in Texas which is our newest Sales Region that we launched at the end of November 2008. This full-size patty is also a ten-pack microwaveable item and will be sold in 25 stores.

"Of course, expectations are very high for all three of these new items and I am extremely excited about the exposure which will be given to CARIBBEAN FOOD DELIGHTS, not only for our new Sales Region but for the other new items and the additional sales that they will generate," says Tim Conway, Director of Sales and Marketing.





THE UK EXPANSION

the Governments of Europe and the United States have granted approval to Caribbean Food Delights to sell our products in the UK reports Tim Conway, Director of Sales. The Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) is the public health agency in the USDA which is responsible for ensuring that the Nation's commercial supply of meat, poultry and egg products is safe, wholesome and labeled and packaged correctly. Caribbean Food Delights has been consistent in its policy of giving the public only the highest quality products and by doing so have gained their trust. We are proud to announce that we are only one of fourteen U.S. manufacturers who are approved to sell meat and poultry products to the United Kingdom and European Union (EU).

The UK Chain, ASDA, is a sister company to WAL-MART. ASDA will be carrying five of our items, namely Spicy and Mild Beef, Vegetable, Curry Chicken, and Jerk Chicken patties. They are all two packs and microwaveable. Already 40 stores located

primarily in Caribbean neighborhoods carry the items. Our ultimate plan is to have the other 400 stores carry them. In the near future, samples of our delectable products will be available in those 400 stores so the public can taste them. Caribbean Food Delights will be the first establishment to sell frozen Jamaican style patties in the United Kingdom. We have several other chains in the UK that are considering carrying these products as well. We have plans of expanding our products into other European Union countries by the Summer of 2009.


